

Photographer Terms & Conditions

1. All photographers must carry full public liability and third party liability insurance and by accepting these conditions indemnify the Royal Highland & Agricultural Society of Scotland against all costs claims and other expenses that they may incur from any third party.
2. Photographers wishing to enter the judging rings can request a numbered tabard when registering for accreditation with the press centre. Only photographers with proven experience in working with livestock or horses will be given a tabard and will be issued at the press office's discretion. This needs to be worn to gain access to the rings and at all times for identification purposes when in the rings. The tabard must be returned to the press office by the end of the Show.
3. All official Livestock & Equine photographers, or those that have been issued with a numbered green tabard, are reminded that they enter the rings entirely at their own risk.
4. All photographers must comply with the requests and instructions of the Society and stewards.
5. Photographers are expected to dress smartly if wishing to enter the judging rings.
6. Photographers are requested to make every effort at all times to avoid obstructing the view of the public.
7. It is requested that photographers work collaboratively and efficiently to avoid delaying proceedings and to minimise disruption.
8. Any photographers in breach of these guidelines will have their tabard/wristband removed, be asked to leave the grounds and will not be allocated a pass to future events.
