



## **Royal Highland Show 2019 – Equine Flu**

Following consultation with veterinary advisors and the Association of Agricultural Show Organisations, the Royal Highland Show has decided it will be mandatory for all horses, ponies and donkeys entering the showground to be vaccinated against equine influenza, according to standard British Horseracing Association guidelines, with the last vaccination having been administered no more than 365 days prior to entry to the showground.

All equines must have completed the primary course of two vaccinations. The last vaccination must have been administered at least 7 days before entering the showground.

Random passport checks will be implemented and any horse without a valid vaccination protocol or owner/exhibitor unable to produce a valid passport will lead to immediate eviction of that horse/pony/donkey from the showground.

Our vets are monitoring the situation on an ongoing basis.
