About the Royal Highland Show

The Royal Highland Show is the biggest agricultural event to take place across the UK and Europe. It's been running for over 200 years.

Each year, over 200,000 visitors attend the Show, including over 20,000 children, 6,000 livestock (that's all the animals!) and 2,500 competitors, making it Scotland's largest outdoor event.

The 2025 Show takes place from Thursday 19th June – Sunday 22nd June 2025 at the Royal Highland Centre at Ingliston in Edinburgh.

About the competition

There are hundreds of livestock and food and drink competitions that take place as part of the Royal Highland Show. That's why we're asking primary school pupils across the country to design a rosette that stands out from the crowd!

This design competition is being run in partnership with the main organisers of the Show, RHASS (Royal Highland & Agricultural Society of Scotland) and the Royal Highland Education Trust (RHET), which works with volunteers to provide free educational activities and experiential learning opportunities linked to Curriculum for Excellence.

In what is RHET's Year of Dairy, we are inviting primary school children (P1-P7) from across the country to design a rosette that will be presented to all the Scottish Dairy Champions.





How to design your rosette

There are two main elements:



Central circle:

Choose one of the following to write:

- a. Champion
- b. Best in Show
- c. Well done
- d. A thistle

Tails at the bottom

Must include the text: 'RHET journey of Food - Dairy' in either Gold or Silver text on the central tail.

Each of these three elements can utilise the following colours or combinations: Red • Blue • Yellow • Navy • Aqua • Cerise • Bottle Green • Orange • Pink • Cream Gold Wine • Grey • Purple • White • Black • Gold sparkle • Silver sparkle
