## **ENTRIES PROCESS**

This gives summary information on how to make entries and includes some useful key facts. For detailed rules, regulations and information about each section the relevant schedule should be referred to.



# **Useful information**

- **Membership Discount-** RHASS Members receive a discount on entries. Membership must be valid, fully paid and in your name. When registering a Competition Entry Account you will be asked to provide your membership number which will validate your discount. If your discount is not applied please contact us before progressing further.
- Entries- an individual entry should be made for each animal and class.
- **Pens/Stalls/Stables** these need to be booked individually and maximums apply for certain sections (further information can be found in the schedule).
- **Parking Passes** all exhibitors planning to park a vehicle during the Show must pre-book a parking pass at the time of entries (including lorries & trailers). This is an optional extra on the entry portal.
- **Caravans** Caravan pitches are available to book for exhibitors in the following sections: Cattle, Sheep, Goats & Heavy Horse & will be subject to meeting entry requirements. Live in trailer & lorry passes are also available to these sections. All can be purchased as an optional extra on the entry portal.
- Additional Accreditation- Through the entry portal you have access to purchase additional wristbands. These should be purchased if you will need more than your allocation which will be given based on your entries. Full details on this can be found in the schedule.
- **U16 Wristbands** U16s go free however when making entries you must book these wristbands.
- **Catalogue & Hay Bale Vouchers** They can be purchased in advance and you will be supplied with a voucher in your exhibitor pack which can be exchanged for the item once at the Show.

### How to register an entry

- 1. Register as a Competitor
- 2. Receive confirmation of completing registration
- 3. Within 30 mins receive log in details and password
- 4. Sign in
- 5. Access your online entry account to make entries etc
- 6. Pay online and print off your invoices

You can return to your entry account to add extras at a later date if required
