About the Royal Highland Show

The Royal Highland Show is the biggest agricultural event to take place across the UK and Europe. It's been running for over 200 years.

Each year, over 200,000 visitors attend the Show, including over 20,000 children, 6,000 livestock (that's all the animals!) and 2,500 competitors, making it Scotland's largest outdoor event.

The 2025 Show takes place from Thursday 19th June – Sunday 22nd June 2025 at the Royal Highland Centre at Ingliston in Edinburgh.

About the competition

The design competition is being run in partnership with the main organisers of the Show, RHASS (Royal Highland & Agricultural Society of Scotland), the Royal Highland Education Trust (RHET) which provides free educational activities and experiential learning opportunities linked to the Curriculum for Excellence and Seaways Services (UK) Ltd which provides a variety of services to the dairy industry, supplying glass bottles, plastics, crates, closures, labels, cream pots and more. In what is RHET's Year of Dairy, we are inviting secondary school pupils (S1-S4) from across the country to design their own milk bottle brand.
