The competition will be held on grass in the Countryside Arena. All fences will knock down. First phase will be six to eight coloured fences with up to two combinations. The second phase will be seven to ten knock down rustic fences including one double. Each phase has a time limit. If time limit is exceeded in the Show jumping Phase time faults will be given at 1 fault per second. After the first phase the competitor will go straight on to the second phase, even if they have faults, (but not if eliminated). For Cross Country Phase an Optimum time will be given – combination closest to this time with the least faults throughout the whole course wins.

**Class 1 – 80 cm**

Fences not exceeding 80cm

Show Jumping speed 325 mpm    Cross country speed 350 mpm    Entry Fee: £25.00

**Class 2 – 90 cm**

Fences not exceeding 90cm.

Show Jumping speed 325 mpm    Cross country speed 350 mpm    Entry Fee: £25.00

**Class 3 – 100 cm**

Fences not exceeding 100cm

Show Jumping speed 325 mpm    Cross Country speed 375 mpm    Entry Fee: £25.00

**Class 4 – 110 cm**

Fences not exceeding 1.10m.

Show Jumping speed 325 mpm    Cross Country speed 375 mpm    Entry Fee: £25.00

## GENERAL REGULATIONS

### Entries

1. Entries must be made online via: [www.royalhighlandshow.org](http://www.royalhighlandshow.org) Paper and telephone entries will not be accepted.
2. Entries for all classes will close on 2<sup>nd</sup> June at 23:59. The organising committee reserves the right to close entries prior to this date if the total entries exceed the maximum number for the day.
3. Competitors must be at least in the year of their 12th birthday.
4. Ponies competing must be 138cms or above.
5. Horse/Pony Combinations may compete in 2 consecutive classes only.
6. If numbers permit in any class, pony rider combinations will be judged with separate results.
7. 1 x Rider and 2 x Support per horse.  
A maximum of 2 Children of 11yrs old or under (connected to the rider) may attend and must stay under the direct supervision of the support team and or owners.  
Children over 11 years of age may attend if competing or where they are the support person for the rider permitted by these protocols. All children must abide by the protocols for sport resumption.  
U18 RIDERS (YOUTH) - Two parents/guardians are permitted.

### Arrival and Departure

8. Entry will be via Ingliston Road following signs to the airport from the A8. Further details will be given closer to the time.
9. On arrival at the Showground, people must follow all directions given to them by the show officials.
10. Riders must not arrive earlier than 1 hour before their allocated warm-up time.
11. Riders must immediately make their way to their lorry/trailer following their competitive round.

### **Collecting Ring**

12. People not specifically authorised to enter the Collecting Ring by the organising committee will not be permitted entry to the Collecting Ring. Riders are not allowed to have their own representative in the Collecting Ring.
13. Anyone found to be entering the Collecting Ring who has not been specifically authorised may be asked to leave the Showground.
14. Riders will be grouped in groups of five and each group will be allocated a time they can enter the Collecting Ring. Riders may only enter the Collecting Ring in their assigned groups.
15. The number of Horses in the Collecting Ring at one time may not exceed five.
16. Each Rider will be allowed at least eight minutes to warm-up before being required to enter the Competition Arena.

### **Start Times**

17. Riders will be grouped in groups of approximately five, no more than eight. Each group will be assigned a Start Time for their warm-up and their competitive rounds.
18. Start Times will be posted online.
19. The organising committee reserve the right to alter the Start Times in certain circumstances such as the fall of a rider. The organising committee will make every effort to inform Riders of any changes.

### **Prizes**

20. Prizes will be awarded in the ring for 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
21. Prize money, where applicable, will be paid via bank transfer.

### **Cancellation**

22. All other rules and regulations as per Equine Schedule
23. In case of cancellation due to adverse weather conditions or for any other reason refunds will be given minus a administration fee or the event re-scheduled to another suitable date.
