Key Information for Exhibitors

What to expect.

- The competition will run as four stand alone one day events held on Thursday 17th to Sunday 20th of June.
- Each day will start at 9.00am (time to be confirmed following close of entries)
- The Showground is split into different arenas, please see map below
- Arena 2 Covers the area of the Main Ring, Countryside Area plus access routes and the Light Horse Float Park. Ring 6 & Thistle Ring will be used exclusively for Show Jumping.
- Exhibitors will not be allowed to leave their respective arenas or assigned rings



Entry Process

Entries will be made via the online entry system found at www.royalhighlandshow.org. All exhibitors will be required to register a new account on the system before entering.

Entries will close at on Wednesday 2nd June 2021 at 23.59

Prompt entry of classes and booking of stables is advisable for this Showcase

Stabling

Limited stabling will be available on site. Preference will be given to competitors travelling from distance and competing on all four days.

Vaccinations

All horses and ponies attending must be vaccinated against equine flu and submit a health declaration form on arrival.

Accreditation

Riders may be accompanied by one person for each horse entered, to a maximum of three people, not including the rider.

Wristbands will be allocated as follows:

- 2 wristbands for 1 horse entered,
- 3 wristbands for 2 horses entered,
- 4 wristbands for 3+ horses entered

Only the following categories of people may enter the showground during the event.

- Rider
- Groom
- Horse owner
- Parent/guardian of rider (if under 16yrs of age)

Entry to the Showground.

Anyone who has shown, or been in contact with someone showing any symptoms of Covid 19 may not enter the Royal Highland Centre showground.

Anyone who, in the opinion of the Covid Officer, is showing symptoms of Covid-19 will be required to leave the premises immediately.

Social distancing must be practiced at all times whilst at the showground. Anyone in breach of the social distancing guidelines will be required to leave the showground immediately.

<u>This is a closed doors event</u>. Absolutely no spectators will be permitted to enter the Showground and no cars will be permitted to park in the lorry park.

The wearing of facemasks is strongly recommended at all times in the showground. Riders will be requested to wear facemasks when walking the track but not when riding.

Lorry parking

Please do not arrive at the showground earlier than one hour before the published start time of your first class.

Vehicles will be stopped at the entrance to the lorry park and personnel details, as listed on your entry form, will be checked by the officials on duty.

Please follow the instructions of the parking stewards at all times.



Warm up

There will be three warm up facilities in the showground.

- 1. Thistle ring (grass)
- 2. Warm up (flat)
- 3. Warm up (jumping)

Competitors will be grouped in bubbles of five and will progress into the warm up facilities as per steward instructions. Times will be allocated for warm up and competition. At any time, no more than five riders will be in each warm up area.

Riders are not allowed to have their own representative in any of the collecting rings.

Competition Arena

Riders will be allocated a competition time and will be called forward by the gate steward. Any rider failing to come forward when called will not be allowed to compete and must leave the warm up area immediately.

Riders must not enter the warm up areas once their round is completed.

When riders have finished jumping all classes entered, they must load up and leave the showground.

There will be limited prize giving ceremonies at the event. Results will be posted online and any prize money will be paid by BACS within 4-6 weeks post Show. If you are due prize money, you will be contacted by email to provide account details.

All competitions are open to exhibitors from the United Kingdom and Northern Ireland subject to the current Scottish Government Guidance



JUMPING COMPETITIONS - CONDITIONS

- 1. All Competitions will be judged under current British Showjumping Rules and Regulations. Attention is particularly drawn to their Rule 82.19 which states "No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury"
- 2. All Competitors must wear Regulation Jackets and hats. Failure to comply may involve disqualification. On the Society's property, anyone on a horse must wear a correctly secured hard hat conforming to the current BSI or European Standard. Headgear must be worn in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 101.
- 3. In regard to show jumping entries, the Exhibitor shall be deemed to be the rider, and full details of the horse(s) and owner(s), including British Showjumping numbers, MUST be given on the entry form. Entries are confined to horses or ponies registered with the British Showjumping and must be ridden by members.
- 4. Substitution entries will be approved only in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79.4.
- 5. The number of entries in each Competition may be limited at the discretion of the Show Jumping Committee, who reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry without giving reason therefor, or to accept additional entries should the class allow.
 In the case of the number of entries in any class (excluding finals) exceeding the number which the organisers consider that they can accommodate, then entries will be limited by reference to the British Showjumping Gold League List. Notwithstanding this, the organisers retain the right to limit the number of horses per rider in any class, in any manner which they deem appropriate. In any case, a refund will be made of the relative fees.
- 6. The Show Jumping Committee reserves the right to alter the times and format of Classes or to cancel any class at its sole discretion.
- 12. Exercising of Stock and moving from Stables. Show Jumping Horses, Light Horses and Ponies may be exercised only in the designated areas of the Light Horse Float Park and Showground, or by order of the Stewards.

Disclaimer of Liability to Exhibitors. The term Exhibitor shall include persons taking part in any competition, exhibition or display arranged by the Society and the owner of any animal, plant, machinery or other thing involved in any such competition or display or otherwise exhibited on the Showground (being all ground occupied or used, or designated for or available for occupation and use, in connection with the Royal Highland Show). Save for death or personal injury caused by breach of its duty, the Society will not be responsible for death, injury, disease, damage or loss caused to any Exhibitor or to his/her servant or agent or to any animal, article, plant, machinery or thing of whatever nature brought on to the Showground by the said Exhibitor from whatever cause death, injury, disease, damage or loss arises.

Save as aforesaid the Exhibitor shall indemnify the Society against all claims, damages and expenses whatsoever in any way arising out of the presence of the Exhibitor, his/her servants, agents, exhibits, vehicles or equipment on the Showground and shall assume full responsibility therefore.

Acceptance of the provisions of these General Regulations shall be a condition of entry. Exhibitors are advised to insure against fire and other appropriate risk not only as regards their own property but also against any third party claims.



ANIMAL HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR HORSES

a) Exhibitors are reminded that Equine Viral Arteritis is a notifiable disease in certain circumstances and that animals placed under restriction for this disease must not be brought to the Show.

b) Horse Passports

- All competitors must carry a valid passport for all horses coming to the Show. Checks may be carried out by the Trading Standards Department of The City of Edinburgh Council
- c) Any Exhibitor from outwith the United Kingdom in addition to the Society's Animal Health Regulations, be required to abide by all British import and export regulations.
- d) It will be mandatory for all horses, ponies and donkeys entering the showground to be vaccinated against equine influenza,

All animals must have completed the primary course of two vaccinations which are given not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart.

If sufficient time has elapsed, the 3rd booster vaccination (which is given not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the second component of the primary vaccination) must have been administered.

Further booster vaccinations must be administered at intervals of not more than 365 days.

Foals under 6 months do not require vaccination.

All vaccinations must have been administered at least 7 days before entering the showground.

The last vaccination date must be entered on the Horse Health Declaration form and handed in on arrival at the showground.

Random passport checks will be implemented.

e) In the event of new Animal Health legislation being enacted between the date of preparation of this Schedule and the date of the Royal Highland Showcase, then exhibitors will be expected to abide by any new conditions of that legislation.



General Rules

- The Show Jumping Committee reserves the right to alter the times and format of Classes or to cancel any class at its sole discretion.
- The number of entries in each competition may be limited at the discretion of the Show Jumping Committee, who reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry without giving reason thereof, or to accept additional entries should the class allow.
- In the case of the number of entries in any class exceeding the number which the organisers
 consider that they can accommodate, then entries will be limited by reference to the British
 Showjumping Gold League list and with preference to those riders competing in multiple
 classes.
- Notwithstanding this, the organisers retain the right to limit the number of horses per rider
 in any class, in any manner which they deem appropriate. In any case, a refund will be
 made of the relevant fees.

Young Horse Classes

Please enter at www.royalhighlandshow.org.

For 2021 these classes will be judged on a Style and Performance basis.

In addition to the showjumping round score, a style mark out of 10 will be given for each fence jumped, plus an overall performance mark out of 10.

Entries in these classes will be limited to a total of 30 entries between both classes.

In the event of equality of League Points at the end of the series, the highest placed competitor on equal points in the International Stairway League Final (British Showjumping National Championships, National Agricultural & Exhibition Centre) will be the winner of the League. The winner of the International Stairway League must be a starter in the International Stairway League Final. In addition the winner of the International Stairway League Final will be crowned the British Showjumping National champion for a twelve month period.

There will be 3 HOYS Wildcards allocated after the International Stairway League Final. The allocation of Wild Cards (N.B Wild Cards will only be awarded to riders currently eligible to compete on a Great Britain Showjumping Team) will be made in the following order of preference:

- 1. To the winner of the International Stairway League (must have started in the Stairway League Final)
- 2. To the winner of the International Stairway League Final
- 3. To the winner of the National Championship Show League

Should the winner of any of the above not be eligible to compete on a Great Britain Showjumping Team or have already qualified for HOYS via an International invitation, the Wildcard will go down the line to the next eligible rider on the respective league, or placing if in the International Stairway League Final.
